CALL FOR ENTRIES - WOW 2001 SHORT FILM COMPETITION

The 11th annual WOW International Film Festival is now calling for entries in the Short Film Competition. WOW is a unique and prestigious showcase of the latest and best work by women nationally and internationally, screening short films, features, documentaries, experimental and digital works.

WOW International Film Festival 2001 - Prizes ...

Best Australian Short Film Prize - the most lucrative single prize for an Australian short with an instant 16mm package of \$30 000 in goods and services for your next film! Includes film stock and processing, equipment hire, access to editing and tracklaying facilities, titling and credits, legal services and training courses. A prize is also awarded to the Best International Short and the UTS Encouragement Award is presented to an emerging filmmaker.

WOW International Film Festival 2001 - Tour ·····

A Touring Festival of the short films travels through regional NSW and national centres, offering selected filmmakers the opportunity to screen their films to a diverse audience. In 2000/2001 WOW toured to Darwin, Alice Springs, Canberra, Adelaide, Perth, Hobart, Taree, Lismore, Byron Bay and Wagga Wagga.

WOW International Film Festival 2001 - Conditions of entry

- 1/ Film and videos must be either directed by a woman, or, if directed by a man, must be both produced and written by women.
- 2/ The Short Film Competition is open to 35mm, 16mm, and all PAL videotape formats. NTSC and SECAM VIDEO FORMATS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.
- 3/ Entries must be less than 40 minutes duration. (Longer entries may be considered for the main festival program at the discretion of the organisers, but will not be eligible for the short film competition. Note: No entry fee for films longer than 40 minutes.)
- 4/ All entries must be on VHS video cassette for previewing. PAL format only and one production only per tape.
- 5/ All entries must be sent postage paid. Please enclose a stamped self-addressed padded bag or postpak if you want your preview cassette returned.
- 6/ All films must be in English or have English subtitles.
- 7/ All films must have been completed in the 18 months prior to the Festival deadline and must not have previously been entered in WOW.
- 8/ Please include stills, transparencies (or tiff/Photoshop eps files on CD or Mac zip disk), cast/crew list, synopsis, and any press material where available.
- 9/ Australian films are eligible for the Best Australian Short Film Award. Entries from countries other than Australia are eligible for the Best International Short Film Award. Both awards are judged by an industry panel. Student and professional films are encouraged to enter.
- 10/ Selection is based on artistic merit and general audience appeal by an industry panel co-ordinated by WIFT.
- 11/ Do not send film prints unless advised. Entrants will be notified if their film has been selected to screen. If selected, filmmakers are responsible for freight of selected films to the Festival, by October 1st, 2001. WOW will pay return freight for selected films only.
- 12/ If selected, the print must be made available for the WOW touring program and may be used by the Festival until the end of December 2001. In the event that the film is requested for other screenings outside of this period, the provision of the print for these screenings is at the discretion of the film producer.
- 13/ The Festival may use extracts from films for promotional purposes and festival publicity.
